Errata and corrections: (Jul 2013)

GENERAL: In many places the word **MUST** is emphasized in bold/upper case. Examples are "**MUST** only" or "**MUST** not". These should often be "must **ONLY**" and "must **NOT**".

- **Page 28:** French Army of Italy 1796-97 (Table):
Divisional Commanders - Competent (Minimum bases): REPLACE "0" with "**1**"
- **Page 35:** Army of Austria in Italy 1796-97 (Table):
Grenzers/Frei-Corps (Total Bases – combined) REPLACE "20" with "**24**"
- **Page 43:** British Expeditionary Army in Flanders 1793-95 (table):
British line infantry – Poor/Drilled: (Maximum Bases) REPLACE "8" with "**12**".
- **Page 50:** Spanish Army of Rosellon: RH Column – 3rd sentence:
"This list is therefore" Insert "**a**" before "whole"
- **Page 67:** French Army of the Rhine 1799-1800 (table):
8lb field artillery: (Maximum Bases) REPLACE "8" with "**6**".
- **Page 70:** Army of Austria in Germany 1799-1800 (customized army):
ADD a bullet point:
 - **Up to 1 mixed division of Austrians can be used.**
- **Page 73:** Bavarian Allies (Table)
Bavarian 6lb field artillery (Maximum Bases): Replace "2" with "**3**"
- **Page 79:** Russian Army in Switzerland 1799 (Table)
Attachments/Officers: (Maximum Bases) REPLACE "1 per division" with "**none**"
- **Page 91:** Ottoman Turkish Army in the Balkans 1799-1804 (table):
Suvarileri: (minimum bases) REPLACE "12" with "**6**"
Bostanci: (Bases per unit) REPLACE "4 or 6" with "**4**"
- **Page 93:** Ottoman Turkish Army in Egypt 1799-1802 (table):
Fellahin: (minimum bases) REPLACE entries of "0" and "6" with a single merged entry of "**4**"
- **Page 95:** French Army Corps D'Armee 1805-1807 (Customized army)
5th Bullet point: "If used, all Imperial Guard ". ADD at the end: "**Any imperial guard used count towards the minimum of the same troop type in the core list.**"
7th Bullet point: REPLACE "this" with "**the main**"
- **Page 98:** French Army Corps D'Armee 1805-1807 (Table)
Guard Dragoons (Minimum Bases): Replace "4" with "**0**"
Guard Artillery: (Minimum bases): Combine both minimums to a single minimum of "**2**".

- **Page 103:** French Allied Contingents 1805-1807 (table):
Wurttemberg light cavalry (Maximum bases) REPLACE “4” with “6”.
- **Page 104:** French Army of Italy 1805 (table):
8lb field artillery (minimum bases) REPLACE “4” with “2”.
- **Page 107:** Austrian Army of the Danube 1805 (Customised Army):
5th Bullet Point: REPLACE entire bullet point “Cavalry divisions must not be used.” with
“Cavalry divisions may only contain heavy cavalry and up to one unit each of light cavalry and horse artillery.”
Austrian Army of the Danube 1805 (table): 6lb field artillery (minimum bases) REPLACE “4” with “2”.
- **Page 109:** Austrian Army of Italy 1805 (table):
Grenadiers (Minimum bases) REPLACE “4” with “0”.
- **Page 110:** The Army of Russia LH Colum – 1st Bullet point:
Replace “but took no part in” with **“and the latter part of”**.
- **Page 112:** Anglo-Russian Expeditionary Force (Table):
British Divisional Commander (Points per General) REPLACE “80” with “70”
- **Page 115:** Russian Army of Austria 1805 (Customized Army):
Dragoons/Cuirassiers (Minimum bases) Combine both to a single minimum of “4”.
Horse Guard and Chevalier Guard (Unit name) ADD **“(Lifeguard)”**
- **Page 116:** Russian Army of Poland 1807 (customized army)
ADD a bullet point:
 - **An infantry or mixed guards division may be selected from the optional troops of the “Russian Army of Austria 1805” list. The full maxima of units may be used.**
 Russian Army of Poland 1807 (Table): Cuirassiers (Maximum bases) REPLACE “4” with “6”
- **Page 119:** Prussian Army 1806-07 (Table):
Core Infantry (Maximum bases – combine total) REPLACE “36” with “40”
- **Page 127:** Ottoman Turkish Army in the Balkans 1805-1808 (Table):
Djellis (Maximum bases) REPLACE: “4” with “6”
Bostanci (Maximum bases) REPLACE: “4” with “6”
- **Page 131:** Swedish-Finnish Army 1808-1809 (customized army):
ADD a bullet point:
 - **Up to 1 mixed division may be used.**
- **Page 139:** Anglo-Portuguese Army 1809-10 (Customized Army):
3rd Bullet point: “Mixed divisions must not be used”. ADD **“except Spanish”**
4th Bullet point: ADD **“or mixed”** after “infantry”.
- **Page 140:** Anglo-Portuguese Army 1809-10 (Table):
British 9pdr Royal Artillery (minimum bases) REPLACE “2” with “0”.

- **Page 142:** Anglo-Portuguese Army 1810-11 (Customised Army)
6th Bullet Point - last sentence "No more than 4..."REPLACE with: "If more than 2 light infantry units are selected they must be replaced with the Optional Light Division."

- Anglo-Portuguese Army 1810-11 (Table):
5th line (Command Level) – 3rd column – Should read "**Points per General**"
13th line (Unit Name) – 7th column – Should read "**Bases per Unit**"
19th line - Highlanders – (Bases per Unit) – Should read "**4 or 6**"
20th line – KGL line infantry – (Bases per Unit) – Should read "**4 or 6**"
21st line – British foot guards – (Bases per Unit) – Should read "**4 or 6**"
Portuguese Cacadores (Maximum Bases): Replace "8" with "4"

- **Page 145:** Allied Army in Spain 1812-14 (Customised Army)
5th Bullet Point - last sentence "No more than 4..."REPLACE with: "If more than 2 light infantry units are selected they must be replaced with the Optional Light Division."

- **Page 146:** Allied Army in Spain and France 1812-1814 (Table):
Portuguese Cacadores (2nd line) (Maximum Bases): Replace "8" with "4"
British & Portuguese 6pdr field artillery (Maximum bases) REPLACE "6" with "4"
British 9pdr field artillery (Maximum bases) REPLACE "2" with "4"
Portuguese line infantry (Light Division) (points per base) REPLACE "10" with "**13**"

- **Page 147:** Anglo-Sicilian and Spanish Army of Valencia 1813 (Customized Army):
5th Bullet point: "Any combination of bases..." DELETE entire bullet point.

- **Page 148:** Anglo-Sicilian and Spanish Army of Valencia 1813 (Table):
British and Portuguese artillery (Maximum bases) Replace "2" with "3"
Attachments: Artillery (Restrictions & Maximum bases): ADD "**per division**" after "one"
Cavalry (Restrictions): DELETE "no more than six cavalry bases in total may be used".

- **Page 150:** Portuguese Army 1809-14 (Customized army):
LH Column last sentence "The Royal Marines" REPLACE "instead of the" with "OR an"

- **Page 157:** Spanish Army 1813-14 (Table):
Grenadiers: CHANGE "Average/Drilled – 8pts" with "**Superior/Drilled – 11pts**".

- **Page 160:** French Corps D'Observation 1808 (Customized Army):
2nd Bullet point: "Mixed divisions must not be used". ADD "**other than the optional guards division which MUST contain 1 of each guard unit.**"

- **Page 161:** French Corps D'Observation 1808 (Table):
Provisional line infantry regiments: Average (minimum bases) REPLACE "4" with "6"
Provisional line infantry regiments: Poor (minimum bases) REPLACE "8" with "6"

- **Page 163:** French Army in Spain 1808-09 (Customized army):
3rd Bullet Point: The Maxima" ADD "**They cannot be used at in the same army as Spanish guard.**"

- **Page 172: COMPOSITION OF DIVISIONS:**
2nd Bullet point: INSERT "**infantry and mixed**" after "All"
6th Bullet point: REPLACE "may contain any number of" with "**at least 2**"

➤ **Page 173: MAXIMA AND MINIMA FOR SINGLE DIVISIONS** (clarification):

The Composition of a single division from another list may also be restricted by the instructions in the main list from which the division is selected. For example: heavy cavalry, infantry, guard, nationality etc. The division selected need only comply with one of these restrictions. The selected division must contain 1/3rd of the minima but may contain up to the full maxima for all troop types selected. All minima and maxima of the troop types not selected are ignored (reduced to 0).

EXAMPLES:

- A Bavarian division chosen from the Allied contingents list (page 102) MUST include at least 4 bases of infantry (12 divided by 3). It need not include Medium Artillery (2 divided by 3 is less than ½ unit). It may contain up to the full number of bases of all Bavarian troops types, (although still restricted by the composition requirements of infantry and mixed divisions).
- A (heavy) Cavalry division taken from the French Cavalry Reserve list as part of the French Infantry Corps (page 95) must only contain heavy cavalry. All minima and maxima for light cavalry and guard cavalry are ignored (reduced to 0). The division MUST contain at least 4 bases each of dragoons and Cuirassiers and may contain up to the full maxima (24 bases) of each. It may also contain a small unit of artillery (3 divided by 2 - rounded up) and up to 1 artillery attachment.

➤ **Page 173: UNIT ATTACHMENTS:**

Add a new Paragraph:

Artillery attachments count towards both the minimum and maximum bases permitted in the main lists of *Eagles and Empires* only. Use the following rules:

- Compulsory attachments do not count against the bases in the main list.
- The full allowance of attachments can be selected if there is no artillery in the main list.
- Artillery attachments are not counted against immobile batteries in the main list.
- Where heavy artillery or howitzer attachments are permitted, they MUST be counted towards any heavy artillery in the main list. If no heavy artillery is listed, these attachment types are permitted as an addition.
- Attachments to cavalry units MUST be counted towards any horse artillery in the main list. If there is no horse artillery in the main list, the full allowance of attachments is permitted as an addition but only for units in a cavalry division.
- Single divisions taken as an attached division to another list may use their full allowance of artillery attachments if no artillery unit is selected for this division, and up to 1 (if permitted) otherwise.
